 - Exhibit original art work in shows and competitions (2 minimum): this includes but is not limited to the Aitkin County Fair, MSHSL regional or state Visual Arts section 7A, Jaques Art Center, Annual Aitkin High School Art Show, Google Doodle, etc.)
- 4. COMMUNITY:
 - a. Complete a 10-hour community service project in the Visual Arts
